Ythan Riding Club Jump Derby



Saturday 18th August 2018 Knock Farm, near Huntly AB54 7LD.

The course will consist of two arenas of show jumps and a section of the cross country course consisting of approximately ten obstacles. The competitor will enter the first show jumping arena and upon completion of this will immediately commence the cross country element of the course. The last cross country obstacle will lead the competitor directly into the second arena of show jumps.

Class 1 - Adult/Junior Open - Max Height: 1.10m (no restriction). This class will be split if there is enough interest.

Class 2 - Adult Intermediate - Max Height: 95cm (no restriction)

Class 3 - Junior Intermediate - Max Height: 95cm (Never to have been placed at Intermediate Level at ODE/Hunter Trials)

Class 4 - Adult Novice - Max Height: 75cm (Never to have been placed at Novice Level at ODE/Hunter Trials)

Class 5 - Junior Novice - Max Height: 75cm (Never to have been placed at Novice Level at ODE/Hunter Trials)

Class 6 - Adult Minimus - Max Height: 60cm (Never to have been placed 1st_3rd at Minimus Level at ODE/Hunter Trials)

Class 7 - Junior Minimus - Max Height: 60cm (Never to have been placed 1^{st} - 3^{rd} at Minimus Level at ODE/Hunter Trials)

Class 8 – Adult/Junior Mini Minimus – Max Height: 50cm. Can be assisted. This class will be split if there is enough interest. (Never to have been placed at Minimus Level at ODE/Hunter Trials)

Junior ages 16years and under.

Entry Fee: £25 YRC members, £30 Non members.

First Aid - £2.50 per rider

RULES

Please refer to BRC 2013 rules for general conduct and the SJ & XC phases, scoring will be as per below:

- 1. Refusals/Disobediences
- Faults converted to seconds
- First disobedience four time penalties incurred (clock keeps running)
- Second disobedience four time plus time (clock keeps running)
- After second Disobedience rider combination must proceed to the next jumping effort. Four time penalties will be added for the non-completion of a question. Rider will proceeds on to next jumping combination with a total of 12 time penalties added (penalized for both disobediences and non-completion of jumping question... clock keeps running)
- If during the first disobedience the jump is altered and needs repair, clock will be stopped while fence is repaired for second attempt. Four seconds time will be added for first disobedience and six seconds (standard) will be added anytime the clock stop's running.
- Combinations Show jumps- When approaching a double/ triple combination if a second refusal occurs at any effort within the double/ triple (if you have a refusal anywhere in the combination you must re-approach from the A jumping effort). Each horse and rider combination has two attempts to complete entire combination. If you leave the combination, four time penalties will be incurred for every jump not jumped, four time penalties for each disobedience and four penalties for leaving the combination (possible 20 time penalties for a triple)
- 2. Outside assistance- Not Permitted
- 3. Start and Finish flagged and timed.
- 4. Eliminations
- Fall of horse and/ or rider (fall of horse if shoulder and haunch on the same side hit the ground) if related to a fence.
- Horse refusing forward motion for a period of 30 sec. will be eliminated
- Other reasons up to Rider or Judges or Committee's discretion
- 5. Loose horse on the course Clock will be stopped until horse is retrieved and clock will start again.
- 6. Faults
- Rail 4 faults converted into time, four seconds
- First/Second refusal, four seconds
- Fall of Rider/Horse, elimination
- -Non-completion of combination, four seconds
- Knockdown of automatic timing equipment or other designated markers on start and finish lines, or flags standing alone marking the limits of banks ditches and water jumps four seconds
- -Stopping of the clock, six seconds
- 7 Tie breaker: If a tie should occur, riders will be required to compete in a jump off
- 8. All horses must be 4 years and over. No horse/pony may go round the course more than once.
- 9. Headgear must conform to PAS015, EN1384 or Higher; body protectors of Beta Level 3 must be work by ALL competitors. Suitable Footwear must be worn e.g. No muckers or half chaps allowed.
- 10. Ythan Riding Club or the Land owners will accept no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury to the public, their vehicles or any horse or rider.
- 11. The decision of the judge is final. Any competitor found guilty of any rudeness to any judge, official or steward will be disqualified and entry fee not refunded.
- 12. Objections must be made in writing to the Secretary within 5 minutes of the completion of scoring and accompanied by a £10 deposit which will be refunded if the objection is sustained.
- 13. All signs must be adhered to.
- 14. Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times.
- 15. The making of an entry implies acceptance of all the rules and conditions.
- 16. XC or YRC club wear must be worn at this event. Long sleeved tops must be worn by all riders.
- 17. Once entry is made a refund will only be given at the discretion of the YRC committee.
