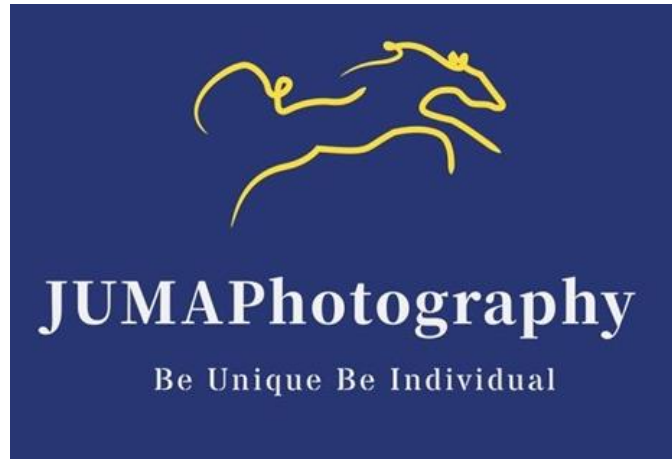

Caledonian Showing Championships

This show is a qualifier for the Caledonian Showing Championships, which offers competitors the opportunity to compete at a top level Championship Final in Scotland. With a draped main arena, amazing rosettes, special prizes, music, judges from the south and atmospheric Evening Performances, this is the show everyone wants to be part of.

This year's show will be held at

Howe EC, near Ladybank, Fife on 17/18/19 October 2025

Every horse & pony placed 1st in all Inhand, Ridden Showing classes (not fun classes) & Working Hunter/Pony classes will qualify to compete in any appropriate class at the Finals. All Champions & Reserves will qualify for the Champion & Reserves Stakes Finals. Qualification will be from placings, no qualification cards will be awarded in the ring, and no qualification can go down the line.

HCR Championship Show Qualifier

The Horse & Country Racehorses (HCR) series is open to Thoroughbreds and Standardbreds who have raced, trained or been bred to race. Racing injuries will be ignored providing the horse is sound. Riders must be 14 years plus, ridden horses must be 4 years plus and veterans are 12 years plus. Judges will not ride and you will not be asked to gallop as a ride but maybe asked to gallop in your individual show.

Qualifying shows are open to members and non-members.

In order to qualify for the HCR Championship Show at Netherton Equestrian, Perth on 6th /7th September 2025:

- HCR members must carry their cards in the ring for signing at qualifying shows and be placed 1st-4th (qualifications *may* be passed down to 6th place)
- Non-members must send their qualification cards (presented by the judge if placed 1st- 4th(6th)), fees and register with HCR before the entries close for the HCR Championship show

First Aid Cover

After careful consideration and review of the Ythan Riding Club Insurance policy along with availability of dedicated First Aid individuals, we will not be providing dedicated first aid cover on the show day. As such, there is no administration fee for first aid and upon entering the show, competitors declare that they acknowledge this.

Rules

1. Entries on the day payable by cash only. NO ENTRIES ACCEPTED WITHOUT FIRST ENTERING and COMPLETING ENTRY FORM AND PAYING CORRECT ENTRY FEE.
2. Rosettes will be awarded 1st – 6th
3. At or in the vicinity of any Ythan Riding Club (YRC) event, everyone mounted, whether competing or not, must wear a hard hat conforming to the minimum safety standards, with a harness properly adjusted and fastened.
4. The wearing of body protectors is recommended.
5. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY: Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organizers or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organizers of any event to which these rules apply, nor Ythan Riding Club, nor the agent, employee, or representative of these bodies accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever. It is strongly recommended that all exhibitors have public liability insurance.
6. Competitors are required to show courtesy towards others when warming up. If riding on the opposite rein to one another competitors should pass left shoulder to left shoulder.
8. The organisers reserve the right to decline any entry, combine, divide or cancel any class, dependant on entry numbers.
9. If entering more than one class, please note that you may have to make a decision as to which class to enter if classes are clashing, classes may be held at the judge's discretion but for no more than 5 minutes.
9. YRC will not be held responsible for any complaint regarding horses or ponies entered in the wrong classes, but will act as a mediator provided the complainer has proof on the day of the show.
10. All stallions should be handled / ridden by a competent adult at all times while on the showground
11. All horses and ponies should be passported and vaccinations should be up to date.
12. All horses and ponies must have an absolute minimum of public liability insurance.
13. The judge's decision is final. Any complaints should be made in writing within 20 minutes of the incident to the Show secretary and accompanied by a deposit of £50
14. All horse dropping must be picked up and taken home
14. Dogs must be on leads and kept under control at all times – please scoop your poop.
15. The making of an entry implies acceptance of the conditions above.
